This audit identifies the "bleeding points" in your supply chain—where inventory disappears and where unauthorized access creates liability. Use this to determine if your current security is an asset or a cost center.

PART 1: THE "RED ZONE" (Shipping & Receiving)

70% of industrial theft happens at the loading dock. How secure is yours?

- **The "Driver Cage" Protocol**
 - Do you have a physical barrier (cage or waiting room) that prevents truck drivers from wandering onto the warehouse floor while waiting?
- **Trash Compactor Policy**
 - Are trash compactors located near shipping docks locked?
 - *The Trick:* A common theft tactic is throwing high-value electronics into the trash to be retrieved later from the dumpster.
- **Seal Verification**
 - Is there a dedicated security officer or manager who physically verifies and logs the seal number on every outbound truck *before* it leaves the yard?
- **"Sweethearting" Checks**
 - Do you have random bag checks for employees leaving the shift? (Prevents employees from sliding free product to friends/family).

PART 2: PERIMETER & YARD DEFENSE

If they can walk in, they can walk out with your profit.

- **The "Fence Line" Walk**
 - Have you walked your entire fence line in the last 30 days to check for cuts, erosion, or stacked pallets that create "ladders" for climbing?
- **Lighting Audit (The 100ft Rule)**
 - Is your yard lighting sufficient to identify a human face at 100 feet at 2:00 AM?



- *Phoenix Standard*: Dark yards invite fuel theft and catalytic converter theft.
- **After-Hours Access**
 - How many people have keys/fobs to the main gate?
 - *Best Practice*: Electronic access logs should be audited weekly to see *who* entered on the weekend.

PART 3: SAFETY & OSHA INTEGRATION

Security is your first line of defense against workplace injury lawsuits.

- **PPE Enforcement**
 - Do your current guards enforce PPE (vests/helmets) rules at the gate, or do they just wave people through?
- **Fire Lane Integrity**
 - Are emergency exits and fire lanes blocked by pallets or snow?
 - *Phoenix Role*: Our patrols include safety hazard reporting, keeping you OSHA-compliant daily.
- **"Lone Worker" Checks**
 - If you run a skeleton crew at night, is there a security protocol to check on them every hour? (Crucial for liability if an accident occurs).
